A Charity Dinner in St. Augustine Fund a School in the Amazon

San Agustín school from Valladolid, held its traditional fundraising dinner for the mission Lábrea (Amazonas) of the Augustinian Recollects. This time it was the NGO Haren Alde of the Augustinian Recollects the channeling of it. frame images. Moraza Bishop confessed how, as St. Augustine school teacher, felt the call to give his life for the mission in the Amazon jungle where he was appointed bishop. Monsignor Moraza put before students the task of evangelization and human promotion of the missionaries on a mission to the extent of half of Spain.

José Luis Garayoa closed the turn of testimony. Thus ended a week when I talked to all students in the school's mission in Sierra Leone. The choir performed three songs San Agustin to put an end to an emotional encounter.

A canteen welcomed nearly 300 guests. Volunteers JAR and catechists of Christian groups coordinated by Father Jose Antonio Roman, donated food

served entirely by Seresca catering. The charity raffle helped various companies in Valladolid, including El Norte de Castilla. The 7,698 euros recaudados is wholly for the mission Lábrea, more specifically, the maintenance of the Hope Center that feed and educate children and teenagers on the street, the construction of decent housing, health campaigns along the river Purus.
